TRAINING NOTES FOR USERS

Understanding Steps in Your Training

Steps = How many times the AI studies your photos

- 500 steps = Quick test (10 min, ~\$1) Just to try it out
- 1000 steps = Standard (15-20 min, ~\$2) Good for most cases
- 2000 steps = Better quality (25-30 min, ~\$3) For more accuracy
- 4000 steps = Maximum quality (40 min, ~\$5) Best possible results

Google Drive Link Setup

- 1. Upload your ZIP file to Google Drive
- 2. Right-click → Get link → Anyone with link
- 3. Your link looks like: https://drive.google.com/file/d/ABC123/view
- 4. Copy the ID between /d/ and /view (in this example: ABC123)
- 5. Your training link becomes: https://drive.google.com/uc?export=download&id=ABC123

Photo Requirements

- 10-20 photos minimum (more is better)
- Same haircut and appearance in all photos
- Different angles: front, sides, 3/4 view
- Different expressions: smiling, serious, talking
- Good lighting (natural light is best)
- JPG or PNG format only
- ZIP all photos together in one file

Photo Format

- Any aspect ratio works (square, portrait, landscape)
- Mix of sizes is fine
- Higher resolution = better quality (phone photos are great)
- Minimum 512x512 pixels
- No heavy filters or effects
- Make sure face is fully visible (not cropped)

Cost Estimate

• Training: \$0.001525 per second

- 1000 steps ≈ 20 minutes ≈ \$2
- Each image generation after: \$0.01-0.02
- No monthly fees pay only for what you use

Tips for Best Results

- Start with 1000 steps for your first training
- Use recent photos that look like you now
- Include variety: different clothes, backgrounds, lighting
- If results aren't perfect, retrain with more steps
- The trigger word "ohwx" is your unique identifier. During training, the AI learned that "ohwx" means you. Always include "ohwx person" in your prompts to generate images of yourself. Without it, you'll get random people instead of you.

- Uploading incorrect file formats:
 Using PDFs instead of .docx or .txt files can significantly
 hinder your GPT's performance. Use formats that your GPT handles
 best.
- Not outlining specific tasks: Without a clear list of tasks, your GPT may produce incomplete or irrelevant output. Be precise in what you expect from your GPT.

None of these strategies will guarantee that your GPT delivers results that can replace your work at the same quality.

Here's a better plan for you:

- Feed GPT with examples that have delivered real results
- Ensure those examples are "human-made"
